# **Hygiene Items**

Soap, shampoo, deodorant, combs, hair brushes, toothpaste, toothbrushes, unscented lotion (small bottles), tampons and pads, toilet paper, small tissue packs

# **Cleaning and PPE**

Hand sanitizer, Clorox wipes, disinfectant hand wipes, durable & disposable face masks (adult & child sizes), non-latex disposable gloves (small, medium, large)

#### Clothing (New or gently used)

Ponchos (adult), children's clothing, children's and adult's winter items (coats, boots, hats), diabetic socks

## **Elder Care Items**

Nutrition drinks, disposable adult undergarments

#### **Food Items**

Individually packaged snacks, gallon water

# **Baby Care Items**

Pacifiers, diapers, diaper cream, baby wipes, baby formula, newborn size hats, baby blankets

#### **Mother Care Items**

Mommy's Bliss probiotics, postpartum supplies, bed pads, disposable underwear, absorbent nursing pads, nipple guards

## Car and Tool Items

Vehicle engine oil, all-season windshield wiper fluid, antifreeze & coolant fluid, shovels, rakes, hammers, tool sets, adjustable wrenches, plyers, screwdrivers

## **Educational Items**

White cardstock, power strips, electric pencil sharpeners, packs of markers, construction paper, child sized scissors, coloring books, small radio with CD player

## Misc, Other

Quart size ziplock bags, emergency blankets, children's books, metered dose inhalers, wrist braces/splints (non-presciption), gift cards to grocery stores, gas stations, etc.
